## Reflection 2

### **DELIVERABLE**

This is an individual activity which invites you to reflect on your experience and performance in the GIM, as well as that of your team mates. It consists of a final peer-evaluation survey, self-evaluation survey and a final short individual reflection paper.

### **DEADLINE**

The peer and self-evaluation surveys will be available on the GIM Learning ePlatform from Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> - Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May (7.30 New York time; 13.30 Barcelona/Milan time; 20.30 Seoul time.)

The deadline for the individual reflection paper is Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May (7.30 New York time; 13.30 Barcelona/Milan time; 20.30 Seoul time.) Students should upload their paper to the Submissions section of the GIM Learning ePlatform.

### **OBJECTIVES**

- Produce a final reflection on your learning experience in the project in terms of the content
- Produce a final reflection on your learning experience so far in the project in terms of team dynamics
- Evaluate your own performance and that of your team mates so far in working in culturally-diverse teams.

**FORMAT**

Your individual reflection paper should be approximately 3-5 pages in length (spacing 1.5 maximum, font Times New Roman or similar, size 12 maximum) and saved in PDF format.

See appendix one for a checklist of sections that ought to be included in your first proposal.

**EVALUATION**

The peer and self-evaluation that you will carry out in Reflection 2 will count for 10% of your final grade (5% peer evaluation and 5% self-evaluation).

The individual reflection paper will not be graded. However, it is a compulsory deliverable and will therefore be taken into account in the tutor's assessment of your performance.
