Registration Fee for the MSc Programmes in Management

The total fee for the MSc Programmes in Management for the 2010-2011 academic year will be **€22,250**. This amount includes tuition fees, academic material and obligatory language classes. It does NOT include travelling expenses related to the student's participation in the International Programmes.

Registration Fee for CEMS Master in International Management

Registration fees for the CEMS Master in International Management programme total **€8,000**.

ESADE awards a grant of **€2,000** to all CEMS MIM participants to assist with relocation expenses during the International Exchange Programme.

Participants should note the extra fee of **€6,000**, which is added to the registration fee for the ESADE MSc Programmes in Management.

The final cost of the combined programme is **€28,250**.

***This grant is awarded to all CEMS MIM participants and is compatible with the Financial Aid Programme described below.**

Student Financial Aid Programme

ESADE is keen that candidates accepted on the MSc Programmes in Management should be able to register in the programme irrespectively of their financial situation.

ESADE has an ambitious grants programme in place for **talented candidates** to the MSc Programmes in Management **with an outstanding academic record and a GMAT above 650**. These grants cover up to 75% of the total programme fees (**€16,687,50**).

In exceptional cases, ESADE will also consider the possibility of providing outstanding candidates with a grant for the full programme amount (**€22,250**).

Before awarding one of these grants, the Committee will assess the student's academic record, the result of the GMAT or ESADE's admission exam, the student's linguistic abilities and other personal skills the candidate can provide evidence of: publications, prizes, distinctions, seminars or courses attended, etc.

Required documentation

- A completed Grant Application form
- A letter addressed to the Committee explaining why you feel you deserve to be selected as a recipient of one of ESADE's talent grants.

Deadlines for Grant Applications

Candidates who meet the requirements can apply for these grants after they have been admitted to the programme. Please note that candidates should reserve their place within the deadline established in the admission letter and should not wait for the Grants Committee's decision.

The Grants Committee meets twice a year with the following **deadlines** to submit grant applications:

- Deadline for the 1st Grants Committee meeting:

Monday, 15th March 2010

- Deadline for the 2nd Grants Committee meeting:

Monday, 17th May 2010

Candidates will be personally notified of the Grants Committee's decision within approximately *4 weeks after the above deadlines*.
