About the Doctoral Programme:

Esade is seeking applications for the Doctoral Programme in Management Sciences starting in September 2024. The Programme is full time and taught in English at our Barcelona-Sant Cugat campus.

This **four-year programme** consists of a one-year Master of Research (MRes), which comprises the specialized research coursework of the PhD (further information: [MRes website](#)), and three years dedicated to the development of the PhD dissertation (further information: [PhD website](#)).

Areas of specialization include: [Strategy and Entrepreneurship](#), [Social Innovation](#), [Marketing and Data Driven Decisions](#), [Leadership& Organizational Behavior](#), [Supply Chain & Operations Management](#), [Innovation and Knowledge Management](#), [Economics](#), [Accounting & Finance](#) and [Geopolitics and Public Management](#). During your application process you have to indicate explicitly which research area you are interested in.

Scholarships and Living Stipends:

Esade provides scholarships that cover 100% tuition waiver and living expenses. Living stipend for the one-year MRes is 17.406€ and for the PhD is 17.650€ during 1st and 2nd year and 18.912€ for 3rd year. TA/RA activities can be performed during the PhD providing extra income.

Application process:

Firstly, you will be requested to fill in an electronic application form (including your area of research interest, a statement of purpose, detailed CV and two letters of recommendation), at the following link: [Apply online](#).

Once you have completed the application, you will receive an email requesting the following documents:

- A research proposal (limited to 3 pages).
- Official transcripts from each school attended (scanned copies to be uploaded in PDF format).
- Scanned, certified copies of all university diplomas in PDF format.
- An official GMAT or GRE score report of a test taken less than five years ago.
- TOEFL score report of a test taken less than two years ago. Exempted: English native speakers or if your university studies were in English (minimum of 3 academic years).

We encourage candidates to apply as soon as possible **applications will be evaluated on a rolling basis until April 21st, 2024**
