Law Courses in Foreign Languages

Requirements for Themis students: Themis students are required to take 30 ECTS worth of courses (including exams) and to pass at least 24 exam credits during the winter term. Since the Themis program focuses on business law and on international law, Themis students have to select their courses from the Themis course catalogue below. However, they may take one course which is not an accredited Themis course from our German-taught course program. Please note that German language courses do not count towards the Themis credit requirement.

Guidelines for direct exchange students: Incoming exchange students from overseas are free to select as many courses and to take as many exams as they are required to do by their home university.

Guidelines for ERASMUS students: Students from our ERASMUS partner universities are free to select as many courses and to take as many exams as they are required to do by their home university. However, they are supposed to choose the majority of their courses from our German-taught program. In addition to the courses taught in German, they may select one or two courses per semester taught in English.
