

THEMIS COURSES

A.Y. 2015-2016

Themis students are required to take at least 30 credits worth of courses and pass at least 24 exam credits during the semester abroad, courses must be selected from a narrow list of Themis accredited courses.

Students are allowed to follow one course (up to 6 credits) offered at the Partner School which is not a Themis accredited course. Students doing an exchange semester at Bocconi are also allowed to carry out a research project (independent study) under the supervision of a Bocconi professor. Project content, length and structure will be agreed between the student and the professor.

Themis students who do not respect the Themis program study plan requirement will be required to change their study plan.

COURSE SELECTION

Course selection will be carried out in the period August 19-27, 2015 and courses are assigned on a FIRST-COME-FIRST-SERVED basis.

Classes will start on September 7, 2015 and students will have the possibility to change their study plan in the period September 10-17, 2015 (upon courses availability). After the deadline (September 17, 2015) changes (add/switch/drop) are no longer possible.
