REQUIRED APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Admission requirements:

- Official home university transcript
- Proof of English language proficiency
- Provide evidence of financial support to cover at least \$10,000 for the living expenses for each semester/term attending at Fordham University

Deadline:

All students (Fall and Spring): Applications must be completed by March 1st.

An excellent public transportation network makes it easy to travel into and within New York City. Options for housing unrelated to Fordham include Educational Housing Services (EHS), a not-for-profit organization that offers furnished housing to students in New York City, and the International House, which is located just a short subway ride from Fordham Law School.
