Faculty Position in Strategy or International Business

ESADE, Department of Strategy and General Management

ESADE is seeking to appoint a tenure-track faculty member at the rank of assistant or associate professor in any specialty area within the fields of Strategy or International Business. The successful candidate is expected to join ESADE in September 2019 or earlier, if possible.

The candidate must have completed a PhD or equivalent program at the time of joining the school, demonstrate a clear trajectory of scholarship in the area of specialization, and the potential and motivation to publish high quality, impactful research in leading strategy or international business journals. The candidate is also expected to demonstrate potential for high-quality teaching in the school's diverse portfolio of undergraduate, postgraduate, (and executive education programs).

The department of Strategy and General Management at ESADE comprises a growing, dynamic group of faculty focused on tackling the issues faced by the general managers, CEOs, and boards of directors of a wide variety of organizations (MNCs, SMEs, family businesses, non-profits, start-ups, etc.). Our research spans different subfields, such as strategic management, entrepreneurship, international business, and family business. The department also constantly strives to translate our research interests and findings into ideas and advice that is of practical use to both future and practicing managers and leaders and enhance the relevance and impact of our pedagogy and classroom experience.

ESADE comprises a business school and a law school, currently spread across three campuses: Barcelona - Pedralbes, Barcelona - Sant Cugat, and Madrid. In turn, ESADE is a member of Ramon Llull University. The school's official mission is "to educate highly professional individuals aware of their responsibilities as national and global citizens, sensitive to issues of solidarity and social justice, and keen to engage in collective projects." Its tagline is "Inspiring Futures."

The compensation, research support and teaching requirements that accompany this position are competitive. Moreover, assistance will be given towards the cost of relocation. For non-Spanish speaking candidates, support is provided to learn the language if desired (speaking Spanish is not a requirement)

Applications will be considered on an ongoing basis until the position is filled.

- Two recent publications or working papers
- The names and contact details of three people who have agreed to act as possible referees
