#### Confidentiality

The application and all the materials submitted by the applicant become confidential property of ESADE. The Admissions Office will not reproduce copiess of any part of the application material for individuals not involved in the admissions procedure, except with written consent from the candidate. Candidates and participants do not have access to personal recommendations and interview reports.

The Admissions Committee will only review completed applications. Candidates are responsible for ensuring that all materials are submitted on time.

## Admissions Guidelines

## Admissions Comittee Decision

Please bear in mind the following guidelines for applying to ESADE's MSc Programmes in Management:

### **General Guidelines**

- Application deadline: All applications must be submitted by the end of June. If you are interested in the CEMS MIM we recommend that you submit your Application for admission before the end of May.
- Applications will not be reviewed until all items on the checklist have been received. The Admissions Committee makes a decision within approximately one month of receiving a complete application.
- All applicants (national and international) are assessed under the same criteria; ESADE has no country or regional quotas.
- All application materials become the property of ESADE and cannot be returned regardless of the Admissions Committee decision. We recomend you keep copies for your own records.

#### Eligibility

The Admissions Committee makes an individual assessment of each candidate and takes into account the dynamics of the whole student group.

### **Candidate Requirements**

Undergraduate degree in business from a recognised university, equivalent to Bachelor's degree. Applicants with a degree in Economics may qualify for admission (to be determined on a case-by-case basis). For the Master in Marketing Management, we will also consider candidates who hold a bachelor's degree in Advertising and Public Relations. All university qualifications should be official qualifications in the country in which they have been awarded.

#### Interviews

The Admissions Committee reviews the application and, as part of the Admission process, may request that you be personally interviewed by one of its members. These interviews are held preferably in Barcelona but if the candidate is unable to travel, an interview can be arranged by telephone. **Students who choose to take the CEMS Master in International Management must participate in an obligatory personal interview**. The purpose of the interview is to confirm that the candidate is a good choice for the Combined Programme and to certify his/her level of fluency in a foreign language.

### Admitted to the programme

Candidates accepted to the MSc Programmes in Management receive a written notification from the Admissions Committee with instructions for completing the administrative process. Candidates are requested to pay a deposit before the deadline indicated in the admissions letter, in order to secure their place in the MSc Programmes in Management.

#### Not admitted to the programme

Candidates not accepted will receive a written notification from the Admissions Committee. Applicants who wish to reapply may contact the Admissions Office at the beginning of the next application season in order to find out why their prior application was not successful.

### **1** Completed Application Form

Carefully fill in the Application Form to start the process. We recommend submitting applications via the Internet at www.esade.edu/onlinemsc The application must be completed entirely in English.

### 2 Transcripts

One of the basic prerequisites for applying to the MSc Programmes in Management is an undergraduate degree equivalent to Bachelor of Science (BSc) in Business. Applicants are required to submit official records from each academic institution attended after secondary school. Academic records must show the dates of enrolment, all subjects or courses, units, credits or hours, exams, and grades in each subject. Applicants must also submit official evidence of the conferral of all degrees, diplomas, or professional titles and indicate the month and year of the formal conferral. These certificates must be issued in the original language. Any documents which are not in Catalan, Spanish, French or English must be submitted with an official translation into one of these languages.

### **3 Certificate of Language Proficiency**

All candidates must be proficient in English. When candidates are required to prove their English knowledge, they must either take an English Examination at ESADE on the same day they take the Admission Test or present any of the following English proficiency tests:

- TOEFL
- IELTSTOFIC
- TUEIC
- University of Cambridge

# ESADE will accept language test scores provided that the certificate was acquired within the last two years.

Those candidates who are native speakers of English or who have studied for a significant period of time in an English-speaking country, should make this known to the Admissions Office. No previous knowledge of Spanish is required, although the Admissions Committee will positively value the knowledge of this or other languages. Those candidates who opt to enrol in the Community of European Management Schools' Master in International Management should credit the command of, at least, three languages, one of these being English. Basic knowledge of Spanish is required for CEMS MIM candidates as they will be required to work on a group project in Spanish in February. CEMS MIM Participants who do not have sufficient knowledge of Spanish should participate in a two-week intensive programme to be conducted before the start of classes (in September).

### **4 Admission Test**

All applicants to the MSc Programmes in Management are required to take an entrance examination. Candidates must either take the GMAT or ESADE's own Admission Test, which is given in Spanish.

The GMAT. The GMAT is administered in centres all over the world and is entirely in English. Candidates must make their own arrangements for the test and should have the original score report sent directly to ESADE by the Educational Testing Service (ETS), the organisation that administers the Test. ESADE will accept test scores provided that the test was taken within the last five years. ESADE's code is 93M-3K-62.

The ESADE Admission Test. The ESADE Admission Test is entirely in Spanish and its structure is similar to the GMAT. You will find the test calendar on our website. Test dates are assigned on a firstcome, first-serve basis as applications are received. However, if you wish to sign up for a specific date, you may do so if there is space remaining.

## Important information for candidates opting for the combined programme: MSc Programmes in Management + CEMS MIM

To enter the CEMS MIM Degree Programme, students undergo a rigorous selection process. Selection is based on candidates' potential to meet the following criteria:

- Knowledge (intellectual and language competencies)
- Interpersonal competencies
- Desire to achieve
- Integrity
- International orientation

At ESADE the CEMS MIM cannot be taken on its own but only in parallel to either of the two MSc Programmes in Management: Master in International Management or Master in Marketing Management. Candidates interested in taking the CEMS MIM should complete ALL the steps in the Admissions Process for the MSc Programmes in Management as previously described. In addition, they should also take note of the following:

- All candidates are required to attend a telephone interview. The purpose of the interview is to confirm that the candidate is a good choice for the Combined Programme and to certify his/her level of fluency in a foreign language.
- As part of the CEMS MIM Admissions Process, candidates need to provide us with the following information. These Essays are complementary to those on page 11 of this Admissions Application. They do NOT replace them:
- How did you learn about CEMS MIM? (approx. 10 lines).
- At which CEMS academic institution would you like to complete the International Exchange Programme? Why? (approx. 10 lines).
- Explain your contributions to and expectations of the CEMS Master in International Management (approx. 30 lines).

#### To bear in mind

Basic knowledge of Spanish is required for CEMS MIM candidates as they will be required to work on a group project in Spanish in February. CEMS MIM Participants who do not have sufficient knowledge of Spanish should participate in a two-week intensive programme to be conducted before the start of classes (in September).
