### Course Goals

This course is divided into two parts:

- The first semester will concentrate mainly on preparation for the TOEFL exam which most students will need for their exchange university.
- The third semester is designed to help students participate effectively during their academic exchange at foreign universities where courses are taught through the medium of English.

### Prerequisites

This course is for students who have successfully completed English II, or who have a level equivalent to C1 or above in the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR)

### Teaching methodology

Classes are conducted in English and students are required to communicate in English with both the teacher and fellow classmates. The approach is interactive and demands full participation and commitment on the part of the individual student and of the group.  
Effective learning also depends on extensive individual work outside class, writing tasks, extensive and intensive reading, studying structural and lexical aspects of the language, preparing seminar presentations and researching course topics. A critical thinking model is applied to written and oral production.
