The Final Degree Project (FDP) involves a months-long research process with a designated director or tutor and a final oral dissertation before a tribunal.

The main role of the designated director or tutor is to provide guidance and methodological support as well as to review the drafting process and approve the final version of the before its final submission (first submission slot is June 2026).

After the submission, the student will have to present and defend his/her research findings before a tribunal composed by ESADE's professors.

Further details on the full process, grading and the research seminar will be provided during a kick-off event on October 2025, as well with a Moodle with resources and a syllabus.
