Course Goals

The course aims to offer a general overview of the social, economic, political and cultural context in Latin American countries. The local and regional specific dynamics have evolved rapidly in recent years due to the internationalization of countries but also given the fact that new foreign and domestic players have emerged (or have strengthened). It will be therefore important to understand the specificities of the regional environment in order to analyse trends but also to analyse current developments.

Teaching methodology

The course will be offered online since the professor is based at the University TEC de Monterrey (Mexico).

The course is intended to be participatory. It will be based on the one hand on a theoretical part in charge of the professor and on the participation of students through two mini oral presentations. In addition, students will have to carry out team research work on a subject of their choice and related to the subject.
