Course Goals

This course builds students' conceptual and theoretical understanding of organizational behavior (OB) equipping them with the analytical tools needed to interpret and navigate complex organizational situations. Students are expected to actively engage with theoretical frameworks, both individually and in teams, applying them throughout their reflective and collaborative work. By the end of the course, students will be able to:

- Apply key concepts in OB and leadership to analyze individuals, teams, and organizations.
- Use critical thinking to assess and respond to complex organizational situations.
- Understand how leadership behavior shapes societal and environmental outcomes.
- Contribute meaningfully to team goals and promote a constructive team environment.

Teaching methodology

The methodology combines individual and team work. Participants will develop different tasks in teams, including a team presentation, which is an important component of the course. They will also participate in role play, debates, case discussions and simulations. Participants combine their work on team assignments with individual reflection. Respectful discussion and debates on the topics addressed are part of the course dynamics. Participants are expected to listen to each other contributions and have a constructive attitude during class discussion. Students are expected to provide each other with respectful feedback that contributes to the quality of their learning processes and personal development. Participation using Moodle and other ICT tools is part of the course dynamics.
