



2026 MRes/PHD in Management Sciences – Call for applicants Funded Programme – **Application Deadline: January 23th, 2026**

Esade Business School offers a rigorous and international academic environment for research operating. Our Doctoral programme consists of a two-year Master of Research (MRes), which comprises the specialized research coursework, and three years dedicated to the development of the PhD dissertation.

Areas of specialization include: Strategy and Entrepreneurship, Social Innovation and Sustainability, Marketing and Data Driven Decisions, Leadership & Organizational Behavior, Supply Chain & Operations Management, Innovation and Knowledge Management, Economics, Accounting & Finance and Geopolitics and Public Management. During your application you will be requested to indicate which research area you are interested in.

Scholarships and Living Stipends:

Esade provides 12 scholarships that cover 100% tuition waiver and living expenses. Living stipend for the two-year MRes is 17.406€ per year and for the PhD is 17.650€ during 1st and 2nd year and 18.912€ for 3rd year.

Application process:

Step 1: Complete the online application form & submit it

Step 2: Once submitted, please log in again to the application system, to upload the requested documentation that includes:

- Official transcripts from each school attended (scanned copies to be uploaded in PDF format).
- Scanned, certified copies of all university diplomas in PDF format.
- An official GMAT or GRE score report of a test taken less than five years ago.
As an alternative, you can register to the Esade Admissions Test, selecting this option directly from the application form.
- TOEFL score report of a test taken less than two years ago. Exempted: English native speakers or if your university studies were in English (minimum of 2 academic years).

Step 3: Interview for the shortlisted candidates.

Deadline: submit your application and provide all requested documents by **23rd January 2026**
